Semester-1: Paper: AR-1.1 (Major & General) Arabic Prose-I and Grammar

This paper provides knowledge of basic Arabic prose and Arabic Grammar which enable them to learn how to pronounce, read and write the Arabic language. The students will get some glimpses of Arabic literature as well through this paper. Over all, the students will step into the world of Arabic literature.

Paper: AR- 1.2 (Major & General) Arabic Poetry-I, History of Islam and Grammar

This paper provides knowledge of basic Arabic poetry, history of Islam and Arabic Grammar which enable them to learn how to recite the Arabic poetry. The students will get some glimpses of political history of Islam as well through this paper. Over all, the students will get some knowledge regarding the above-mentioned topics.

Semester-2: Paper: AR-2.1 (Major & General) Arabic Prose-II and Grammar

This paper provides knowledge of Arabic prose and Arabic Grammar broadly to some extent which enable them to learn more about the Arabic language. The students will acquaint themselves with the Arabic literature as well through this paper. Over all, the students may be aware of the Arabic language and literature.

Paper: AR- 2.2 (Major & General) Arabic Poetry-II, History of Islam and Grammar

This paper provides knowledge of basic Arabic poetry, history of Islam and Arabic Grammar which enable them to learn how to recite the Arabic poetry. The students will get some glimpses of political history of Islam as well through this paper. Over all, the students will get some knowledge regarding the above-mentioned topics.

Semester-3: Paper: AR-3.1 (Major & General) Arabic Prose-III (Qur'an, Hadith & Nasihat) and Grammar

The students will get the knowledge of the Arabic prose from the selected Qur'anic verses, some selected hadiths and some suggestions and advices of intellectual persons of the old ages. In the part of grammar, the students will be able to make sentences in Arabic applying appropriate grammar.

Paper: AR- 3.2 (Major & General) Arabic Poetry-II, History of Islam and Grammar

This paper provides knowledge of Arabic poetry, history of Islam and Arabic Grammar which enable them to learn how to recite the Arabic poetry. The students will get knowledge the caliphs Mu'awiyah, Marwan, Umar bin Abdul Aziz and Hisham bin Abdul Malik as well through this paper. In this way, the students will be acquainted with the system of caliphate in the era of Islam.

Semester-4: Paper: AR-4.1 (Major & General) Arabic Prose-IV History of Islam and Grammar

The students will get the knowledge of the Arabic prose from the famous Arabic book namely "Kalilah wa Dimnah" written by the great author Abdullah bin al-Muqaffah. They will study regarding the caliphs like Abul Abbas al Saffah, Abu Ja'far al-Mansur, Haroon al-

Rasheed and al-Ameen in the Islamic history section. In the part of grammar, the students will be able to form new words using different forms Arabic etymology.

Paper: AR-4.2 (Major & General) Arabic Prose-V Literary History of the Arabs (Pre-Islamic Period) and Grammar

The students will get the knowledge of the Arabic prose from the famous treaty known as “Sulhul Hudaibiyyah” agreed upon by prophet Muhammad (PBUH) and the famous tribe of Mecca named “Quraish) They will study regarding the literary history of pre-Islamic period which is known as ‘Dark’ age in the literary history section. In the part of grammar, the students will get the knowledge of syntaxes.

Semester-5: Paper: AR-5.1 (Major & General) Arabic Prose (Medieval Period)

The students will get the knowledge of the Arabic prose from the selected Qur’anic verses, some selected hadiths and some speeches of prophet Muhammad (PBUH) and Abu Bakr (R.). Along with this there are two Maqamah which are considered very rich piece of literature. In the part of grammar, the students will be able to make sentences in Arabic applying appropriate grammar.

Semester-5: Paper: AR-5.2 (Major & General) Arabic Poetry (Pre-Islamic Period to Abbasid Period)

The students will get the knowledge of the Arabic poetry from pre-Islamic period to Abbasid period covering different famous poets of that period. In this way, the reader will be able to know the culture, living style and social status of the people of that period.

Semester-5: Paper: AR-5.3 (Major) Modern Arabic Poetry

The students will get the knowledge of the Modern Arabic poetry. They will be acquainted with the famous poets like Ahmad Shauqi Bek, Hafiz Ibrahim and Ma’ruf al-Rusafi and enjoy their poems and hence they will get knowledge. Semester-5: Paper: AR-5.4 (Major) Rhetoric, Grammar, Essay and Translation

In this paper the students are taught the different rules of rhetoric like Ilmul Bayan which covers Tashbih, Al-Majaz al-Mursil etc. then the special characters of the Babs of Arabic grammar known as Ilmul al-Sarf. They are also taught how to write essays in Arabic. Along with this, the students are enabled how to translate a text from Arabic to English and vice-versa.

Semester-5: Paper: AR-5.5 (Major) Literary History of the Arabs (Umayyad and Abbasid period) and Semitic language.
