In a bid to understand and address the pressing socio-economic issues plaguing rural communities, the Department of Economics at B.P. Chaliha College undertook a comprehensive survey in the adopted Pijupara, Daspara village on 11th November 2023. The survey, conducted aimed to shed light on various facets of village life, ranging from income levels to healthcare access. A socio-economic survey at Das Para village was conducted by the 1st semester and 5th semester students of Department of Economics in supervision of teachers of the Department on 11/11/2023. Total 38 numbers of household were surveyed by a pre-designed questionnaire.





Key findings from the survey revealed a mixed bag of challenges and opportunities faced by the residents. Among the most notable discoveries was the prevalent unemployment rate, significantly impacting the economic well-being of the village. Lack of sustainable livelihood opportunities emerged as a pressing concern, with a substantial portion of the population relying on erratic seasonal employment. In terms of infrastructure, the survey indicated a need for significant improvements in roads, electricity, and water supply systems. Poor road connectivity was identified as a major impediment to economic development, hampering the transportation of goods and services to and from the village. Despite these challenges, the survey also uncovered several strengths within the community. The spirit of entrepreneurship was evident among the villagers, with many engaged in smallscale businesses and cottage industries. Additionally, strong social cohesion and community solidarity were observed, serving as foundations for collective action and mutual support.

In conclusion, the socio-economic survey conducted by B.P. Chaliha College's Economics Department serves as a crucial step towards understanding the complex dynamics of rural life and fostering inclusive growth of the said village.
