Topic: 'Women and Rural Development'

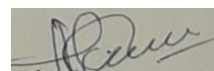
Resource Person: Dr. Anjan Jyoti Borah, Assistant Professor, Department of Political Science

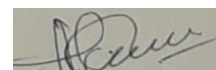

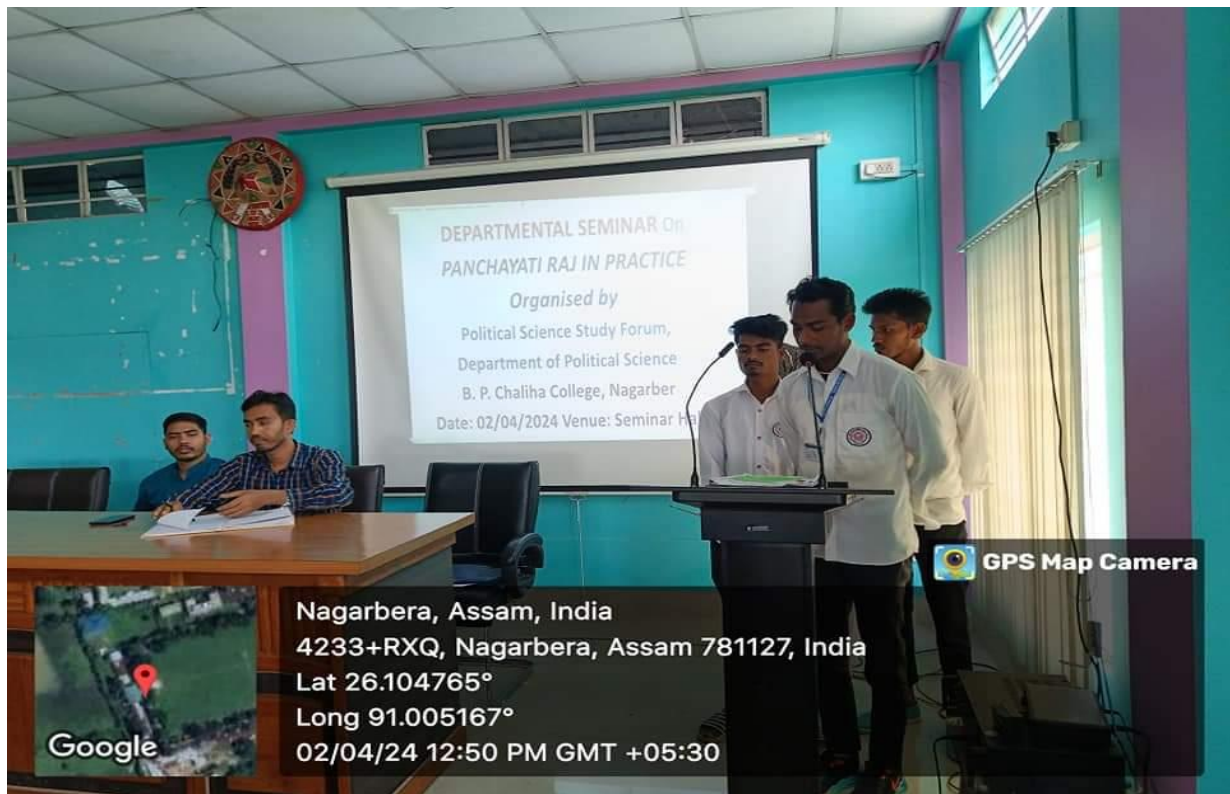
