Covered banking operations, financial services, insurance, payment systems, loans, AML, financial markets, and E-KYC processes with case study.



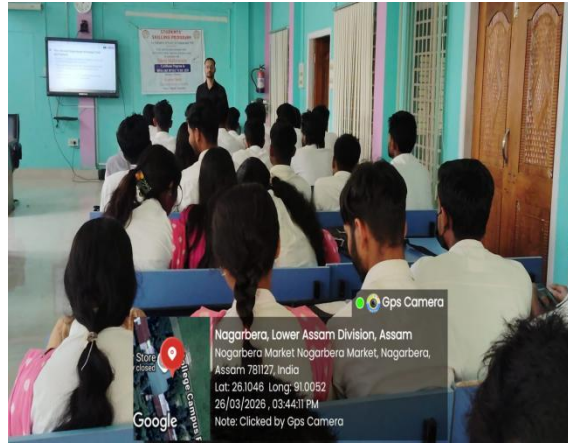
## Day 2: Mutual Funds and Investment Strategies (25-03-2026)
