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An awareness programme on the *Bal Vivah MukT Bharat* Campaign was held on **29 December 2025** at **B. P. Chaliha College, Nagarbera, Assam**. The programme was organised by the **Women Cell** in association with the **Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)** of the college. The observance was conducted as per the instructions of the **Ministry of Women and Child Development, Government of India**, as part of the **16 Days of Activism for ending Gender-Based Violence**.

The programme was chaired by **Mrs. Anita Keot, Head of the Department of Geography**, and the resource person for the event was **Ms. Firoza Ahmed, Head of the Department of Economics**. The resource person delivered an insightful talk highlighting the social, legal, and economic consequences of child marriage, stressing the importance of education, awareness, and community participation in eradicating this social evil. She also discussed the legal provisions related to the prohibition of child marriage and the role of youth in creating a *Bal Vivah Mukat Bharat*.

The programme witnessed active participation of **around 134 students**, along with faculty members from different departments of the College. The interactive session helped in sensitising the participants about gender-based violence and reinforced the need for collective efforts to ensure the protection of children's rights. The programme concluded with a collective pledge to work towards the elimination of child marriage and to promote gender equality and social justice in society.
