

## A brief report of activities, enrolled and result of KKHSOU study center, B. P. Chaliha College

### Programmes & Academic Activities

As an active Open and Distance Learning (ODL) hub, the centre bridges the gap for local, working-professional, and socio-economically disadvantaged learners across Kamrup, Barpeta, and Goalpara districts. The major activities across the last three sessions included:

**Course Offerings:** The centre consistently facilitated undergraduate and postgraduate learning, primarily focusing on Bachelor of Arts (B.A.), Master of Arts (M.A. programs in English, Assamese, History, Political Science, Sociology and Education), Master of Science in Mathematics, and Master of Commerce.

**Induction Programme:** To welcome and orient new learners, the KKHSOU study centre at B.P. Chaliha College systematically organises an induction programme following the conclusion of each admission cycle. These sessions serve as a crucial gateway for distance learners, introducing them to the open education system, the evaluation structure, and available institutional resources.

Over the last three academic cycles, these programmes were strategically scheduled to align with university timelines. For the 2023–24 session, the induction was successfully conducted on August 7, 2023. In the subsequent 2024–25 session, the orientation took place on 21<sup>st</sup> November, 2024, while the event for the 2025–26 academic year was held on October 30, 2025.





During these sessions, the coordinator and academic counselors brief the newly enrolled students on navigating Self Learning Materials (SLMs), submitting mandatory home assignments via the online portal, and preparing for term-end examinations, thereby ensuring a smooth academic transition.

**Counseling & Contact Classes:** Conducted mandatory weekend/Sunday face-to-face counseling sessions utilizing the college's ICT-enabled classrooms to discuss Self Learning Materials (SLMs) and clear academic doubts.

**Continuous Evaluation:** Annually organized the submission, coordination, and evaluation of mandatory Home Assignments via the KKH SOU Study Centre Panel Login portal.

**Examination Management:** Whenever the university designates our study centre as an official examination venue, we conduct the KKH SOU final examinations with the utmost discipline, integrity, and transparency, ensuring a clean and smoothly managed environment for all candidates.
