
- 1. **Projectors: 05** number projectors are available in different classrooms/labs

- **6. Digital Library resources**: The library is using SOUL 2.0 Integrated Library Management Software (ILMS) for creating library databases. One number of server and four numbers of clients are working in the SOUL 2.0 environment. 
Different Uses of ICT Faculties


- A. **PowerPoint presentations-** Faculties are encouraged to use PowerPoint presentations in their teaching by using LCDs and projectors. They are also equipped with digital libraries, online search engines, and websites to prepare effective presentations.
- B. Seminar and Conference rooms are digitally equipped where guest lectures, expert talks, and various competitions are regularly organized for students.
- C. **Online competition**: From time to time the faculties organize online competitions eg essay writing for the benefit of the students with the help of Google Forms.

- D. **Video Conferencing**; Students as well as faculties are counseled with the help of Zoom / Google Meet applications.
- E. **Video lecture**: The **139 different video lectures links** are made available to students on our college websites for long-term learning and future referencing. Besides this 18 live discussion sessions were also added to our website.
- F. A total of 1098 **class notes** are added and made available on our college website for the students. Interested students can log in, download, and study the uploaded documents.
- G. Different WhatsApp groups are also constructed in different departments of our college to use as a teaching-learning tool. Different notes, notices, and pieces of information are shared with students.
- H. Google Classrooms is widely used by faculty members for the decimation of class notes, assignments, and other information related to class.


