Date: 19-01-2023

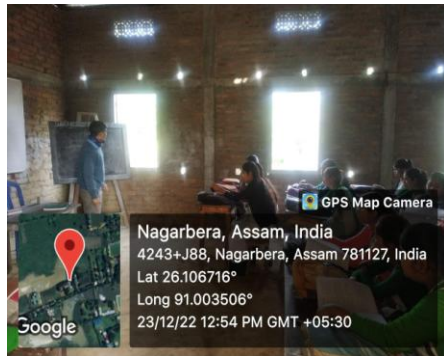

Date: 08-03-2022

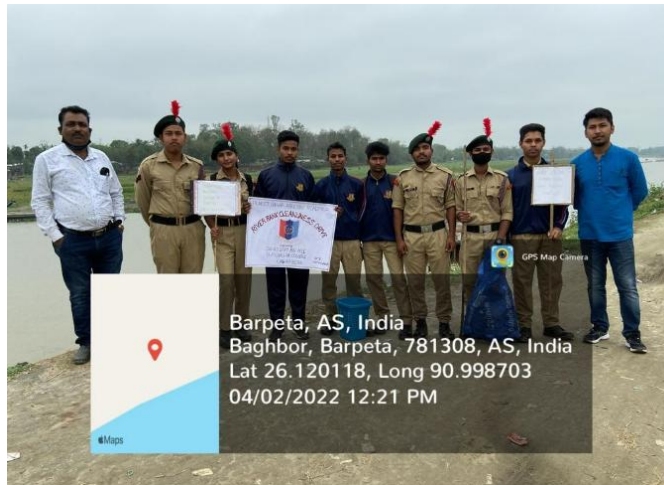
