1. Name of the activities: Celebration of Yoga Day

Date: 21-06-2023

Description: The 9th International Yoga Day, 2023 was celebrated with the theme: Yoga for Vadu Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam' i.e. Yoga for the welfare of all in the form of 'One World-One Family'. It emphasizes the spirit of Yoga, which unites and takes everyone along. Our Instructor Mrs. Anita Keot, Department of Geography taught the students the importance of yoga and its benefits which was followed by an invigorating yoga session led by experienced instructors. Students and faculty are invited to participate in a series of yoga asanas (postures) and pranayama (breathing exercises) to enhance physical fitness and mental clarity.

The programme featured a series of informative sessions and workshops conducted by

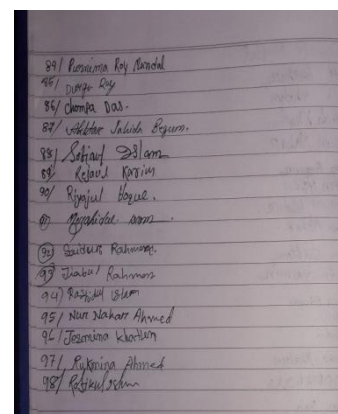
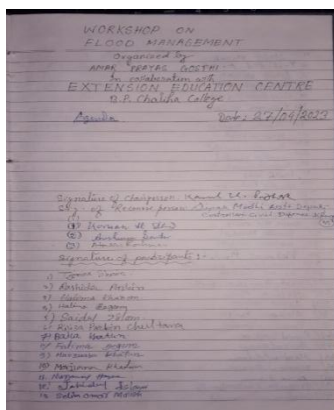

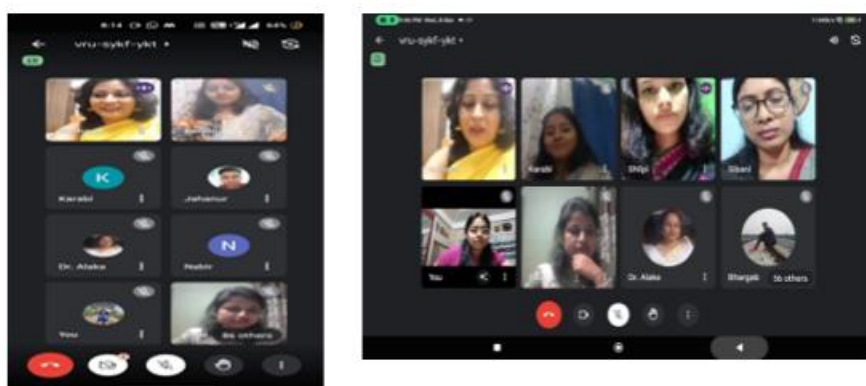


5. Name of the activity: Celebration of International Women’s Day

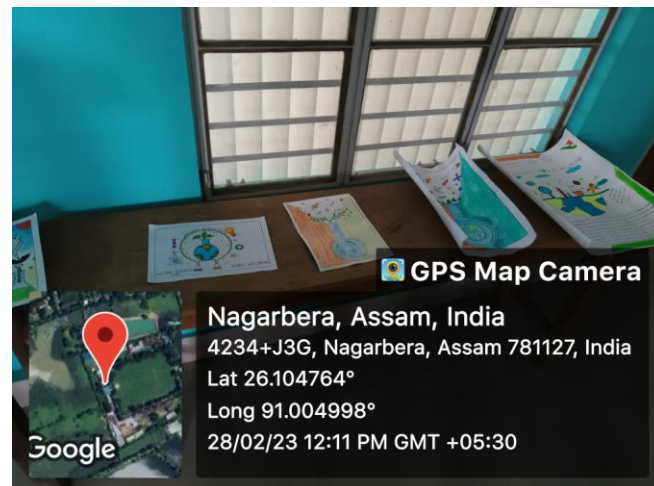
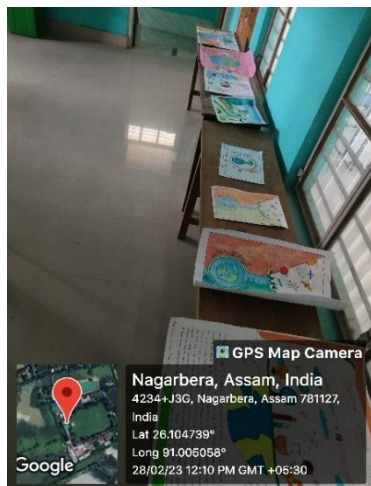


6. Name of the events: Celebration of National Science Day

Date: 25-08-2022

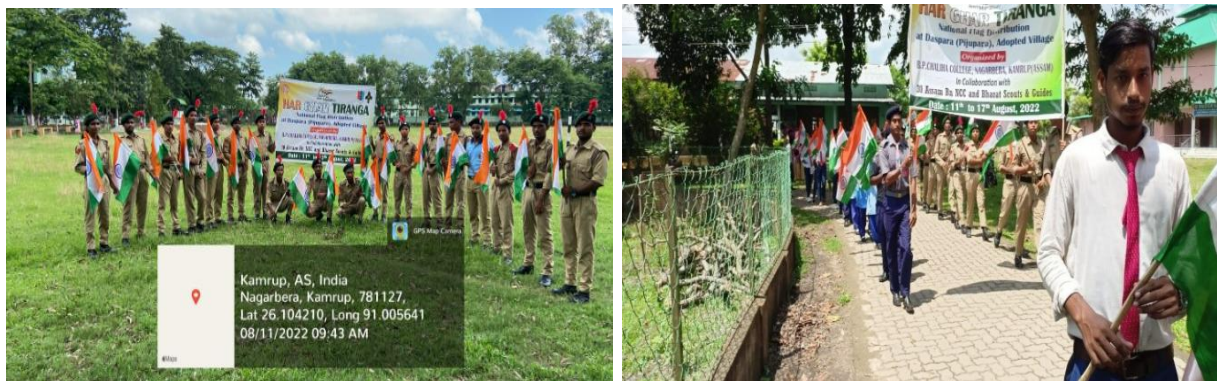

Date: 09-11-2021 to 15-11-2021

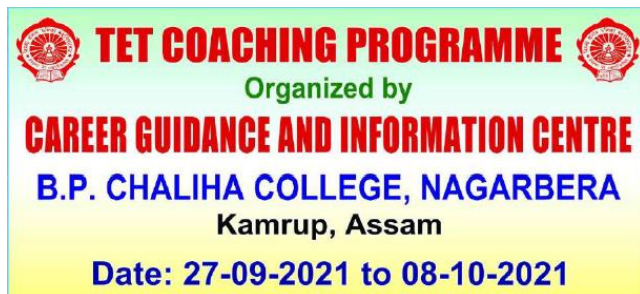
Cadet from NCC, B.P.chaliha College namely Parishmita Das was selected for the Uttarakhand trek from 9/11/21 to 15/11/21.
